

The Courage of Conviction

The “weeping prophet” endured the heartbreak of seeing his beloved nation of Judah demolished by a Babylonian army even as he pleaded with his people to surrender to God’s will. Jeremiah was a man of immense conviction, and God’s commission to the “Anathoth Agitator” did NOT promise him an easy task and a receptive audience (Jeremiah 1:1): Instead He commanded Jeremiah to...

*“...go to all that I shall send thee, and whatsoever I command thee thou shalt speak.”
(Jeremiah 1:7)*

About halfway through his ministry, God sent Jeremiah into the temple courtyard just as the reign of Jehoiakim was beginning, to tell all the nation that unless they repented of their evils He would destroy both the nation and the city (Jeremiah 26:3-6).

- The warning was direct; **listen**.
- The promised punishment was dire; **destruction**.
- The path of preservation was plain; **penitence**.
- But the hearers were **hostile**, and their hearts were **hard**.

Jeremiah followed the Lord’s instruction exactly, but faithful king Josiah was now dead and evil Jehoiakim ruled instead; wicked priests and false prophets urged the masses to seize Jeremiah, intending to murder him for telling the truth. When news of what was happening in the temple reached the nation’s princes, they convened a court at the “new” gate of the temple to investigate (Jeremiah 26:10f). The priests and prophets wanted Jeremiah killed because his message foretold doom for them AND destruction for the temple. They believed the temple’s continued existence proved that God approved of all their evil, so they understood that Jeremiah’s words condemned them.

When the princes heard what Jeremiah had said (and had been saying for more than twenty years - see chapter 7), and saw that he would not “back down” but stood firm on God’s message, they declared

*“This man is not worthy to die: for he hath spoken to us in the name of the LORD our God.”
(Jeremiah 26:16)*

They not only recognized Jeremiah’s courage and boldness, they also remembered the example of Micah the Morasthite who had proclaimed similar words in the days of king Hezekiah, and brought about a great national repentance (verses 18-19). Recently, however, king Jehoiakim had murdered the prophet Urijah for preaching about the need for repentance. Unlike Jeremiah, he ran away in fear instead of standing firm when the evil king sought his life (verses 20-23).

Jeremiah stood his ground despite opposition from priests and other prophets because he was committed to God. When challenged, he was blunt about why he preached such an unpopular message so openly; because the Lord sent him to say these things, Jeremiah 26:12. Jeremiah did not cower or compromise at the prospect of suffering for his faithfulness (verse 14), but affirmed both his innocence and his authority as the spokesman of Almighty God. He was truly God’s man because his great courage was born of his conviction; he was certain that God’s way was right!

How much courage do **we** have? When others sin openly before us, do we speak or keep silent? When bible words about morality, honesty, justice, and responsibility meet jeers, catcalls and ridicule do we speak up for God or “tone it down?” When we know someone will think we are unsophisticated, narrow-minded or “neanderthal” for presenting God’s word do we speak anyway? Do **we** have courage born of the conviction that God’s way is best?

In conclusion, we ask, can you be satisfied rapidly and speedily marching toward eternity having patterned your life after matters which you cannot find in the Scriptures? This is a serious matter!
