

I'm a Christian, not a "Church-of-Christ"

There is a basic and unavoidable difference between the church of the new testament and the modern world's denominations: One is from heaven, but the others are not. We may be tempted to just ignore this distinction; virtually all denominations teach "some" truth, and there are many sincere people in them. Many of us have friends and close family members in denominations, and that can make it hard for us to point out the difference. It often feels easier to just say "I'm Church-of-Christ" than to explain the difference between being a Christian and being part of a denomination.

If God doesn't care if we follow His pattern for the church, then any differences between the church in the new testament and a denomination don't matter. If it does matter to God, we need to see plainly what sets His church apart from those created by men. We should follow the new testament's model for the church because...

God's Son built it and died for it. He was unmistakably plain in Matthew 16:18; "I will build my church." A church built by or belonging to someone else is not His! The church of the new testament was bought with the blood of Jesus, Acts 20:28. It is not possible to honor both the will of Christ and men's opinions in matters of religion, Acts 7:23. We were redeemed by the blood of Jesus (1 Peter 1:19); therefore, we should keep His will in religion!

No man-made religion can rightfully claim the heritage of Christ's church! Simply saying "this church belongs to Jesus" doesn't make the statement true: A church that wears someone else's name gives Him no glory; and one that elevates human doctrines defies His will. Jesus Christ's blood purchased no denomination.

Denominations are not "part" of the church. Many think "which church" doesn't matter as long as we belong to one. This is ridiculous because contradictory teachings cannot both be true and

most religions disagree with each other. Jesus said that the truth can make us free (John 8:32), but if my "truth" contradicts your "truth," at least ONE of us is NOT free! Did "which church" matter in Corinth (1 Corinthians 1:11-13)?

Some justify religious division with the claim that denominations are the "branches" of John 15. Verse 6 makes it plain, however, that Jesus spoke of individuals, not different and contradictory denominations. Those who are saved are "in" Christ:

1. We are one body in Him, Romans 12:5.
2. We are made alive "in" Christ, 1 Corinthians 15:22.
3. We become new creatures when we are "in Christ," 2 Corinthians 5:17.
4. We come "into" Christ through scriptural baptism, Galatians 3:26.
5. ALL spiritual blessings are "in Christ," Ephesians 1:3; none are found in religions made by men!

The point is simple: Jesus built no denominations. There is no hope and no salvation in them! Human religions are not part of the new testament church!

"Salvation" in a man-made religion is a fraud. It is a false promise. It is fake because the terms of receiving it vary from denomination to denomination. Some teach "faith only" (note James 2:17-19), while others proclaim "works only" (see Ephesians 2:5 & 8). All teach "as doctrines the commandments of MEN," Mark 7:7. No denomination can deliver true salvation from sin; only Christ can provide that, Acts 4:12 ("in the name of Jesus" means by HIS authority).

God wants us to be saved! He is unwilling for any to perish, 2 Peter 3:9. He loves us so much He offered a perfect sacrifice for us, John 3:16. He has given us plain instructions for salvation. Instead of ignoring what seem (to us) like "little" differences, let's encourage everyone to do it right from the start!

Tests of Christian Maturity

A conversation with a dear friend sparked a fresh study of James 1. The conversation focused on this chapter and related to why brethren often err from the way of God. By turning the viewpoint from why some to that of considering how so many become strong and mature as Christians, one can consider the following tests of Christian maturity. Note the text of James for the scriptures in detail.

1. The test of overcoming trials in life (vv. 2-8). Trials do and will come. How are they overcome? Note the emphasis in these verses on faith, patience, maturity, wisdom, prayer, stability and joy. Yes, trials come and are difficult to bear, but the maturing Christian holds to such virtues and endures as James instructed that we do.

2. The test of one's values in life (vv. 9-11). The maturing Christian, whether of low or high estate in this world's goods, realizes that the true and proper values, standards, directions, and authority in life do not have their center in this age and place. He/she has been blessed of God in becoming his child. The humble man, in this world's view, has been exalted to membership in God's family; the wealthy person, materially blessed with the possessions of this world, has been humbled to become obedient to Christ. The maturing Christian realizes the proper ratio and relationship between the material and the spiritual in this life.

3. The test of resisting temptation (vv. 12-18). Temptation to leave God, do evil, fall short of God's glory is often met. The mature Christian knows such is not from God but rather is the result of one's giving in to evil desires and appeals. The inevitable result is spiritual death. Such deception must be resisted. God has blessed and does bless; His purpose gives strength and guidance in such moments of temptation.

4. The test of receiving God's word (vv. 19-27). The attitude of heart, readiness to hear and learn, is crucial. One is a doer and not a hearer only. The life is impacted for good by the word as it is welcomed and obeyed. This leads to the salvation of the soul and is to be highly prized as one goes on to completeness. There are other insights for the maturing Christian in these verses. We are encouraged to read again and meditate on this great book.

- * If your car starts once in every three tries, is it reliable?
- * If your paper boy skips delivery every Monday and Thursday, is he trustworthy?
- * If your refrigerator stops working for a day or two every now and then, do you say, "Oh well, it works most of the time?"
- * If your water heater provides an icy-cold shower every now and then, is it dependable?
- * If you miss a couple of loan payments every year, does the bank say, "Ten out of twelve isn't bad?"
- * If you fail to worship God one or two Sundays a month, do you expect to be called a faithful Christian?

We expect faithfulness and reliability from things and other people. Doesn't God deserve the same from us? The problem is that in our religious activities we see ourselves as volunteers rather than duty-bound (I Cor. 9). For volunteers, almost everything seems acceptable. For a bondservant who is duty-bound, faithfulness is expected. (Matt. 25:21).
