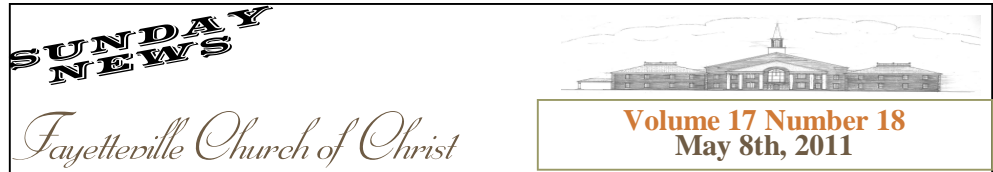

MOTHERHOOD
 Jerry Manning

In 1914 President Woodrow Wilson declared that Mother's Day should be celebrated as a national holiday on the second Sunday in May. Since then, once every year our country stops to say thank you to her mothers. Flowers, cards and gifts are just the outward signs but the fact that families take notice of what their mothers do and for one day make them queens for a day is a good thing. I am convinced that we do not spend enough time expressing our gratitude to our mothers. I am sure I speak for all at the Fayetteville church of Christ in saying thank you to our mothers for their instinctive and natural and selfless sacrificing that they have shown to us all of our lives; we are so very grateful to you. To those who are adoptive mothers or foster mothers, thank you for the sacrifices you are making to take such unique and challenging situations and use them to lead those little children to God in such a remarkable way. What a tremendous thing you are doing and God bless you for it.

This morning I will be preaching a sermon about motherhood that will be focused at the young girls who are aspiring to be mothers. It is my hope to elevate motherhood to the height of the heavenly loftiness that God placed it when he created Eve. *(Gen.3:20) And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the mother of all living.*

God established separate roles for man and woman and when we fulfill these roles as God intended then the wisdom of God is manifested in our marriages, our families, our communities, and in our church homes.

Satan on the other hand organizes such things as the Feminist Movement to blur these distinctions and convince women they are equal to men in all areas. Now we have mothers with new born babies leaving them to go into battle zones on the other side of the world and fight as combat soldiers on the front line. If one of these soldier's motherly instincts cause her to disregard her military obligations and stay with her children, she will be hunted, arrested and imprisoned as a deserter.

The Virginia Slims cigarette brand was introduced in 1968 and marketed to young professional women using the slogan, "You've come a long way baby!" Forty three years later our women have gone so far beyond "a long way" that we can't even tell them apart from men. What is most appalling is the abandonment of motherhood for careers and the mass murder of the unborn for convenience sake.

Motherhood is part of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and is an integral part of God's design for the development of every human being. Even Jesus, God in the flesh, had a mother who never left his side and was with him as he died on the cross and when he rose from the dead. Our job as Christians is to resurrect motherhood into the hearts of our young girls as God intended it to be. May God help us achieve this most lofty goal!
