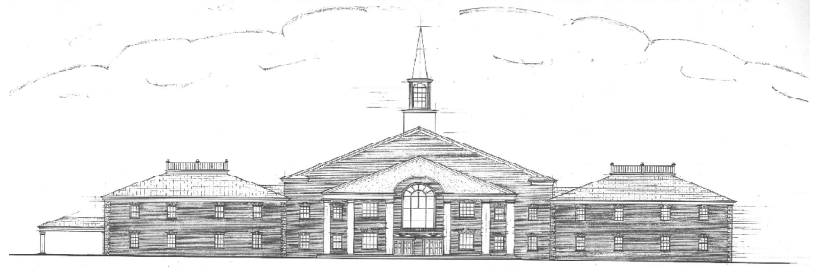

PUTTING ONE'S HOUSE IN ORDER

Imagine trying to find a specific book at a library that had no system of cataloging, documenting and shelving of books. It would be impossible to locate one among the thousands if they were all just randomly placed and stacked throughout the building. This simple illustration helps us understand the importance of having order in all areas of our life. With chaos comes confusion and vulnerability to sin and that is why David wrote in (Psa.119:133) *Order my steps in thy word: and let not any iniquity have dominion over me.*

In (2 Kings 20:1) the prophet Isaiah went before Hezekiah the king of Judah with a message from God, *Thus says the LORD: "Set your house in order, for you shall die, and not live."* God warned Hezekiah of his imminent death so that His faithful king could dispose of his affairs, give his final charge to his household and possibly write his will. As Christians we are to live as if today is our last day and our house is in order. Peter spoke of Jesus returning for the Judgment Day in (2 Peter chapter 3). *But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up (v. 10).* In other words, Jesus could return this very hour and then it would be too late to put things in order. Notice Peter's conclusion in (vs. 17-18), *You therefore, beloved, since you know this beforehand, beware lest you also fall from your own steadfastness, being led away with the error of the wicked; grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Falling from our own steadfastness implies that we had put things in order but then let them become disorderly. Growing in grace and knowledge of our Lord implies a constant state of improvement as we apply God's system of order to our lives.*

Paul refers to us as ministers of Christ and stewards in (1 Cor.4:1-2), and states, *Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful (v.2).* A steward is the manager or overseer of a house. Note the word *minister* not *master* and *steward* not *Lord*. We are to keep the Lord's house orderly and as faithful stewards always be ready for the Master's return. Jesus gave a parable about this in (Luke 12:42-48). Therefore let us manage those things the Lord has given us to serve Him with: time, money, and talent, to His glory.
