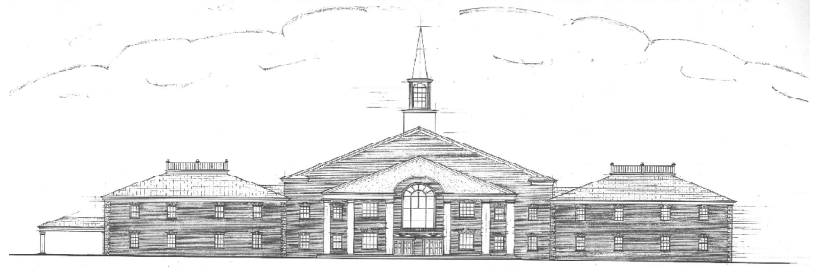

PUTTING FIRST THINGS FIRST

This is my eighth bulletin article since arriving at Fayetteville and each week I like to discuss things that are pertinent to the entire congregation. By including God's wisdom from the scriptures hopefully we will all benefit as we apply it to our lives. Of course the desire of each member and of the congregation as a whole is to please God in our service to Him. God's overall goal is the salvation of souls, adopting them as His precious children. We are included in this rescue operation as partners with God, *(1 Cor.3:9) for we are laborers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.*

I was reminded the other day by a very wise sister in Christ of the necessity of prayer and I wondered why I had not made this the topic of my first bulletin article. After all, it would have been *putting first things first.*

Our Lord Jesus clearly taught and vividly demonstrated the necessity of prayer in everything he accomplished. Before selecting his apostles he prayed all night, *(Luke 6:12-13) ...Jesus went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God. And when it was day, he called unto him his disciples: and of them he chose twelve, whom also he named apostles.* Can we ever forget the agony of Gethsemane and how Jesus wanted his apostles to remain awake and pray with him? Once, Jesus cast a demon out of a child and the apostles asked why they could not cast it out. Jesus answered *(Mark 9:29) this kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.*

I am convinced that we will not be successful in our ministries, whether in evangelism, edification or benevolence if we do them without much prayer. How can we be *laborers together with God* if we don't communicate with Him in all that we do? When we are told to *pray without ceasing* in *(1 Thess.5:17)* that means that we pray: before we decide what to do, as we make the decision, before we put that decision into action, while it is being done, and upon completion, giving thanks. Without prayer we get the idea that we are the ones accomplishing great things at Fayetteville and that we are the cause for any growth or enthusiasm or souls being saved. But we are to know our place and position as we kneel with our heads bowed before Almighty God and recall *(Eph.3:20-21) Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.*

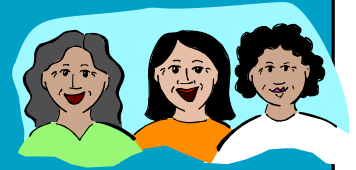
