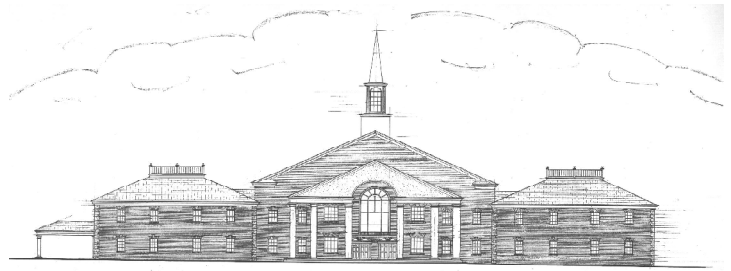

If you finish this article and continue reading our bulletin you will find a host of Christians, family members and friends in need of prayer. You will also notice that whatever you are facing in this world of trials and tribulations there are many facing the same, if not worse. Those without faith often ask, "How could a loving God allow His children to suffer so?" And then when suffering comes to the faithful many ask the same question. We find the answer in the Book of Job.

Aside from our Lord Jesus, no Bible character endured more than the patriarch Job. Although he remained faithful and would not curse God we find that he did not understand what was happening to him and blamed God. (*Job 9:17*) *For He (God) breaks me with a tempest, and multiplies my wounds without cause. He will not suffer me to take my breath, but fills me with bitterness.* Job just wanted his "day in court" but when the Judge of the Universe finally showed up it was God who did the talking and Job who remained frozen in silence.

Job learned that it was Satan who was to blame and we need to understand the same about our world. Is it God's fault when a drunk driver crosses the line and kills an innocent family? We cannot blame God for the consequences of our sins. (*James 1:13-14*) *Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempts he any man: But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.* What we need to do is thank God for extending His great mercy and love in order to save us in spite of ourselves.

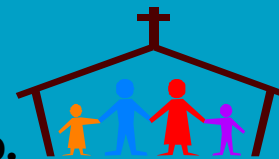

(*James 1:2-3*) *My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.* It is because of our relationship as children of an omniscient heavenly Father that we learn to overcome worry. Jesus tells us *not to worry about life, what we will eat or what we will drink; nor about our bodies, what we will put on; because our heavenly Father knows that we have need of all things* (*Matt. 6:25, 32*). In (v.30) he used the phrase, "O ye of little faith, in connection with anxiety. Faith then is the answer to all that we must face. Let us have the faith of Job in full knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18).

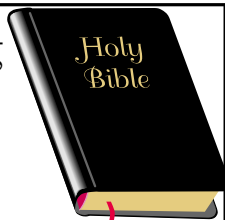

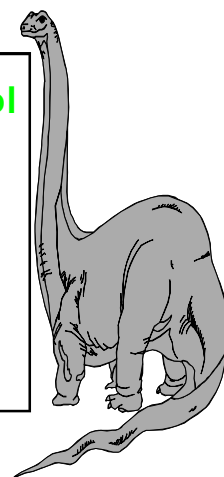
