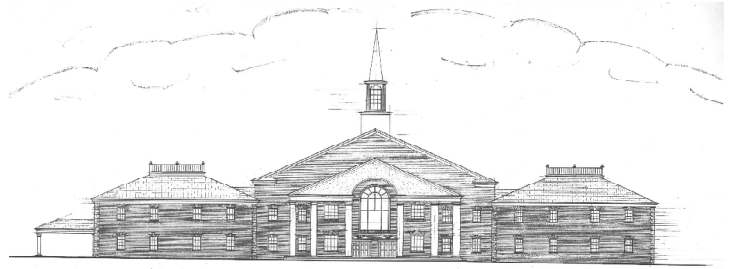

“IT’S ALL ABOUT THE JOURNEY”

Last Sunday evening we had a celebration for our graduating seniors: Eric Kelly, Jessa Quinn, Lexy Smith and Crystin Nash. These bright shining stars from our congregation have prepared themselves to go out into this vast world of opportunities and grab hold of their dreams. I'm sure they are filled with mixed emotions and that is why we who have journeyed before them need to encourage and support in every way possible. They need the confidence to overcome any doubts or fears that may hold them back and they need spiritual vision to establish their life's goals on a path of righteousness. *(Prov.2:8-13) God keeps the paths of judgment, and preserves the way of his saints. 9 Then will you understand righteousness, and judgment, and equity; yea, every good path. 10 When wisdom enters into your heart, and knowledge is pleasant to your soul; 11 discretion shall preserve you, understanding shall keep you: 12 to deliver you from the way of the evil man, from the man that speaks wicked things; 13 those who leave the paths of uprightness to walk in the ways of darkness.*

It's all about the journey and who we choose to follow along the way. There are two choices, God's judgments that preserve us or the ways of evil men who walk in darkness. John tells us to walk in the light, (1 John 1:7) and there is a way to do that no matter where your journey takes you. Our young adults may leave this city to go off and attend colleges, start new careers, or get married. They need to do so while walking in the light and that doesn't happen inadvertently. Neither does one attain a college degree inadvertently. First, no matter where one lives he must identify with a local congregation and submit to the leadership of that church. *(Hebrews 13:17) Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account.*

Second, find time to labor and work for that congregation. As we must be good stewards of our money and return a portion to help the church, we must do the same with our time. If you are too busy while in school, nothing will change when you graduate and go into a career or when you get married and start a family. Remember this doesn't happen unintentionally; it must be purposed in your heart and scheduled on your calendar.

Third, Bible is a subject you will always have. Study it daily, (2 Tim.2:15) and teach it to anyone who is interested. Daily prayer and singing will habitually follow as we take all our concerns to our Father and remain thankful for all His blessings.
