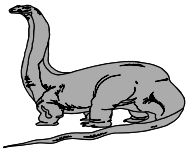
Two Memorial Days Back to Back

Tomorrow our nation will observe Memorial Day to honor our fallen heroes, the 1.1 million Americans who have died in the nation's wars. The Athenian leader Pericles offered a tribute to those who died in the Peloponnesian War over 24 centuries ago that could be applied today. He said, "Not only are they commemorated by columns and inscriptions, but there dwells also an unwritten memorial of them, graven not on stone but in the hearts of men." As beneficiaries of those who have given the ultimate sacrifice let us actively remember our ancestors, our family members, our loved ones, our neighbors, and our friends. Because of them our freedom as Christians has been preserved.

Today is also a Memorial Day as each and every Sunday is for Christians throughout the world. We gather as congregations to eat the Lord's Supper in the unity of the Spirit. (1 Cor.10:16-17) *The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? For we, though many, are one bread and one body; for we all partake of that one bread.* The apostle Paul would continue on this theme by stating that the establishment of this supper came from Jesus himself, (1 Cor.11:23) *For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you...* It seems that our Lord wants his death remembered: (v.24) *"Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me,"* and (v.25) *"This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."* We then notice the duration of this memorial (v.26) *For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.*

What is notable is that we partake of this significant commemorative on Sunday, the day of our Lord's resurrection, (Acts 20:7) *Now on the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread...* Therefore, as somber as our time together is at the foot of the cross, we the beneficiaries of this great sacrifice know with blessed assurance that the ultimate victory has occurred. The perfect life of the Son of God was given so that eternal life could be given to all who will receive it. (1 Cor.15:22) *For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. (V.54) Death is swallowed up in victory. (V.57) But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.*

Why is this memorial service so important to us and to God? Because it helps us remain, *steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord (v.58).* God is asking for spiritual soldiers who will commit their lives to defend truth and righteousness and we are reminded each Lord's day of the price that was paid for us. (1 Cor.6:20) *For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.*
