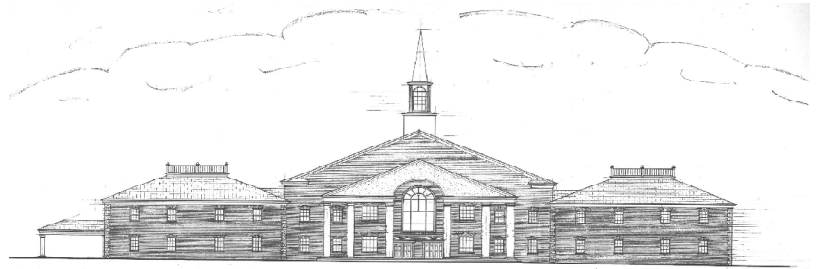

The Final Welcome Home Jerry Manning

Last week I wrote about the wonderful welcome we received as we moved to our beautiful home on the Hurt estate and how great it was to be welcomed with such an outpouring of love. As Christians it is quite obvious to us that God is working in our lives and we can honor and praise Him for all the good He bestows upon us. (James 4:15) *For that ye [ought] to say, If the Lord will, we shall live, and do this, or that* (KJV).

It is a strange thing to settle oneself in a home knowing that we are just pilgrims on this earth as sojourners in a foreign land. (Hebrews 11:11-16) tells of Abraham and Sara and how they died in faith never seeing the promises of God through them coming to fruition. We too have promises from God yet to be fulfilled and must have the same mindset that Abraham and Sara maintained throughout their life's journey— (Heb.11:16) *But now they desire a better [country], that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for He hath prepared for them a city.*

The happiest people I ever met were lepers in a Christian community in India who were celebrating the release of a brother into Paradise.

Until we make heaven our home this world will distract us from serving God. Jesus made it clear in (Matt.6:24) that *no man can serve two masters*, therefore we must *seek first the kingdom of God* (v.33) and God will take care of all our needs on this earth. The FINAL "welcome home" will be when Jesus returns to take His church, His bride, His body, His brothers and sisters to Heaven.
