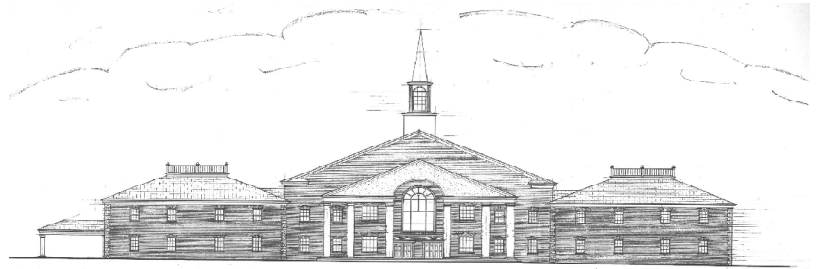

HIT THE ROAD RUNNING

In my meetings with the elders it was mentioned several times that they wished I had more time to transition into my job but unfortunately I have to "hit the road running." I assured them that I have been running for a while now and don't mind the pace. My question to them was, "what are we running after?" and to my delight I found a united eldership with a passion for souls: the souls of the lost, the souls of the saved and the souls of the wayward weighing heavy on their hearts. "We must run to secure the souls of this church and run even harder to reach the lost souls of this community," was their reply.

When it comes to souls, time is of the essence. Wednesday, Jan. 12, we had a memorial service for Sarah Guith's uncle, Tim Cessna who died at the age of 32 in a house fire. His mother, Linda Wooley wrote, "He was taken from us way too soon. I never thought it would have been me left to mourn him" (Psa. 118:24) tells us, *This is the day the LORD has made; We will rejoice and be glad in it.* In other words, today is when we have to do the Lord's work. I once heard a preacher say, "Yesterday is a cancelled check, tomorrow is a promissory note, but today is money in the bank." Jesus told his disciples in (John 9:4) *I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can work.* The Hebrew writer emphasizes the importance of today in (Heb. 3:13) *exhort one another daily, while it is called "TODAY," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.*

The idea of running coupled with the urgency of the day paints a picture of how important our work is as Christians. I can think of no other Christian who understood this more than the apostle Paul. He was a spiritual marathon runner who did more to spread the gospel throughout the world than any other. Just before his execution he wrote a letter to his son and companion in the faith, Timothy, encouraging him to continue where he left off (passing the baton). (2 Tim. 4:5, 7-8) *But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry. 7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. 8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.* It is time to "hit the road running."
