We sing the song, *Standing of the Promises*, "Standing on the promises of God my Savior, standing, standing, I'm standing on the Promises of God." Peter said, "Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."
