“The Truth, The Whole Truth, And Nothing But The Truth”

In the book of Acts, chapter 16, verses 16-19, the apostle Paul had to deal with a slave girl who was possessed with a spirit of divination. Her owners profited from this girl's fortune-telling. As Paul went about the city preaching, the girl began to follow him and would cry out in the street, “These men are the servants of the Most High God, who proclaim to us the way of salvation.” This persisted for many days until Paul, greatly annoyed by it, turned round and cast the spirit from her. This upset her owners whose business came to a sudden end and Paul was beaten and thrown into gaol.

Why was Paul so annoyed with the girl? Did she tell a lie? No, she didn't. Paul was a servant of God who preached salvation from sin through faith in Jesus. Yet, Paul was annoyed and responded. Why? Some might suggest that the girl was very sarcastic, even derogatory in her tone: but we can't read her tone. Was there another reason?

Jesus said that we “shall know the truth and the truth shall set us free” (John 8:32). Later He would pray to God on behalf of His disciples, “Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth” (John 17:17). John had no greater joy than to hear that his children “walk in the truth” (3rd John 4).

Truth is a powerful thing that has toppled Presidents and embarrassed politicians. Jesus' teaches us that His message is truth and that it alone teaches us how to be saved from sin (Romans 1:16) and that having been saved we should walk, that is, to live according to what that truth teaches.

Paul wasn't annoyed by what the slave girl said: he was annoyed that her life (she was possessed by an evil spirit) contradicted that message. Those who are Christians can not be Christians in name only. Our lives must reflect the truth of the gospel (Romans 12:2). We are to tell the truth, we are to live the truth and we are to serve the truth: the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth – so help us God! Does your life contradict the truth?
