A sense of belonging gives one an assurance of security, connectedness, value, ownership and the list could go on and on. Listed are several ingredients that will create a recipe for a positively functioning family.

- PLAN, include each family member, inclusion fosters ownership.
- BE ALERT to each family member and their development.
- DETERMINE the role of each family member.
- EDUCATE each family member of their role, parents this is your primary responsibility.
- WORK each family member must work on assimilating each member in the family including themselves.
- PRAY with each family member, individually and collectively. God's bank of blessing is opened through prayer, pray just one more time each day..

Remember each person needs and deserves a place to belong. We are God's adopted children. It is great to know that God has a place for each one of us in His Family. Assimilation, the effort is minimal and the results are bountiful, try it and you will see.
