# Think Family

A recent study stated that the knowledge base has increased from doubling every seven years to now every four years. What does this mean for us as those who constantly think family? Grandparents, parents and children, this phenomenon of fast growing knowledge has a tremendous effect on each person in the family. I am amazed at what our children know. They have tremendous knowledge at a much younger age. I can turn on a computer and occasionally operate one, I have been heard to say, " I am going to throw this thing (computer) out in the yard." My 16 year old child can make a computer do things that I had no idea existed, oh the memories of an I.B.M. Selectric.

The World Wide Web better known as WWW has information on it that will open the world to our children. They can see places and learn about places that I only knew existed because of a globe. The WWW has allowed our children to access information much quicker. For an example, Bible study, what in my day took hours of searching, reading and referencing our children today, by the touch of a button, can have the information instantly. Today our children cannot complete their homework without a computer with the WWW. I think this resource is wonderful and should be available to our families. But as with everything we must proceed with caution. Consistency and moderation are key elements in parenting and these two skills are a must with the WWW.

There are things that are appalling that can be seen on the WWW, our children can be exposed to horrible, sinful things that many well-aged adults have not seen or heard about. The WWW will consume our children almost instantly if RESTRAINTS are not put in place to keep our children protected. With these things in mind what must we do? Let's lay down some guidelines for computer use in the home from the Bible.

- Maintain a close relationship with your children. Genesis 22:2  
Remember parenting is all about relationship!
- Maintain involvement in your child's everyday activities. Ephesians 6:4  
Know who their friends are. Stay in the know as to what they are studying and what their interest are. Pay attention to their interactions with their peers.
- Maintain communication with your children constantly. James 1:19  
Speak, listen and watch.
- Maintain your Christian walk. I Timothy 4:12  
Remember, they are watching and imitating.

Our children are amazing!!! With good parenting skills and application we will raise a dynamic, educated and motivated generation of Christians. And with the proper use of resources they will be able to share the good news of Jesus with the whole by way of the WWW.
