Developing

Before I left school I did a course in photography. I enjoyed it and over the next few years bought an SLR camera and the equipment needed to develop my own photographs. I could only do black & white but I think that that was more fun anyway. Having taken my photographs, I'd break open the film canister in absolute dark. Slowly I'd thread it into a drum and then transfer it into a developing cylinder. Chemicals were added and drained and then the film could be removed and I could see the negatives in the light. Then, I'd go into the darkroom and with a little red lamp in the background, I'd expose photo paper to the negatives, develop and fix them and then I'd have a permanent record of my work. I really enjoyed photography.

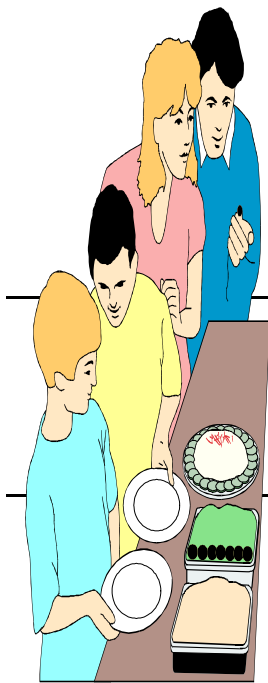
I still do, though today it's a digital camera, Photoshop and a colour printer. I'm not in the dark anymore and I still enjoy photography albeit with the nuances of today's technology.

Unlike photography which has undergone significant change in the last few years, the nature of mankind remains in the same need today as it did 2,000 years ago. When Jesus walked on this earth He preached the gospel that His disciples then took to the world. They committed those teachings to the Bible we have today and the message remains the same: man's sin leaves him in darkness and only Jesus can bring it into the light. The Apostle Paul's mission in the Gentile world of the first century was to "...open their eyes and to turn them from darkness to light..." (Acts 26:18). Their lives were exposed to the light of the world (John 8:12) through the preaching of the gospel.

The Christian is slowly developed. It is nurtured and matured so that its full glory may be realised. Peter talks of "newborn babes" (I Peter 2:2). The Hebrew author talks of the need to move from milk to solid food, that is to say, that our souls should develop into maturity (Hebrews 5:12-14). Paul tells Timothy that it is the Bible that provides us with all that we need to come to maturity as Christians and that the Scriptures provide all we need "...for every good work" (II Timothy 3:16-17).

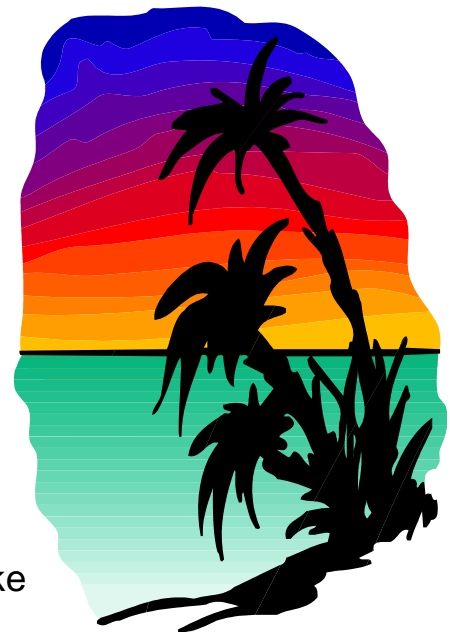

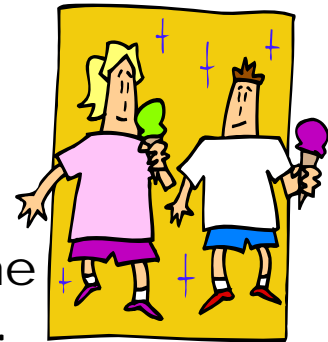
