History Was Made in China

History was made today in Beijing, China. Beijing Church of Christ met for the first time sanctioned by the Chinese government. Ron Brown from Peachtree City Church of Christ traveled to China and met the provincial leaders and Aubrey Johnson will be the first Christian speaker.

BROWN'S TOWN, JAMAICA CAMPAIGN REPORT - Written by Rob L. Whitacre

"And when they were come, and had gathered the church together, they rehearsed all that God had done with them..." (Acts 13:27).

On Friday morning July 11 a group of 58 brothers and sisters traveled to the airport to begin the Great Mission to go and teach the Jamaican people the Gospel of Christ. All arrived in Montgo-Bay on time. Upon arriving at the Hotel we checked in and had orientation.

When we arrived into Brown's Town that morning we had a huge job. We organized all of our supplies, set up two dental exam rooms, one physical exam room, one reception room, a pharmacy, a campaign supply room, a waiting room, an eye screening and test area, built a sink and sterilization area, set up a huge campaign tent, set up four areas for vacation Bible school, set up our PA system, secured water for drinking, and a host of other chores. During the late afternoon about 25 team members headed towards the busy market to begin handing out flyers. Thousands of people swarmed us with interest in the medical mission. Sunday was the Lord's Day and it was a joy to worship with our Jamaican brethren. Our teachers did a great job along with Brother Joey Barkley who preached his first sheet sermon. During the afternoon we traveled to the Walker's home, where lunch was served everyday. Her cooking was excellent and it would be one of the highlights of the trip.

Sunday afternoon began our mission. Our medical team began by seeing Jamaican brethren. Our construction crew prepared to "rebuild the wall," our VBS team prepared for the children, our evangelism team did a little door knocking and some began conducting Bible studies at the tent. That evening we had our first tent meeting with Brother Jack Honeycutt planting the seed of God's Word. We had over 120 in attendance!

Each evening I would meet with the work coordinators and make plans for the next day. Upon our arrival into Brown's Town on Monday morning all our plans were thrown away. Literally hundreds of Jamaicans were in the compound waiting, with children running all over the place. We had prayed that God would send the masses and He answered in a big way! Crowd control began immediately. I want to personally thank Brother Tommy Durden for his help in this area. It was not until his smiling face met the restless Jamaicans that we fully gained control. The teams quickly set up their work. Bible studies abounded every day, our medical mission team was overwhelmed with requests, our VBS had more children than they could manage, and our construction crew began rebuilding the wall. It was wonderful to see all the children wear their VBS shirts every day, and waiting in line to get into their classes.

Due to the teaching efforts of Jamaican and American brethren alike several responded to the Lord's invitation. First, there was Marion Walters who came forward on Monday evening during Jack's sermon on "The Cart Before The Horse." That night we traveled down to the beach and witnessed the new birth of John 3:5. We prayed and sang together rejoicing with the heavenly host. In ensuing days she would be joined by Jennifer Shand, and Mandal Johnson.

On Thursday morning rain changed our plans. We decided to take a half day and allow for some rest and souvenir shopping. Brother's Jack Honeycutt, Brandon Clark, Terry Jones, Buck Baskin, Mel Hutzler, Denny Harris and I traveled across the island that morning to check on two other works. Brother Winston's house was completed and they were living in it. The church buildings in Old Harbour and Sandy Bay were nearing completion. These three projects have been in the works for many years and all I could do was smile and give God thanks. That afternoon the weather cleared and by 3:30 we were again working at full speed in Brown's Town.

The most touching of all conversions had to be Ms. Beverly Don. She had been attending the VBS classes and helping our teachers. I asked to speak with her one late afternoon and we spent a couple hours in Bible study. She began to see many things the Bible taught that the Pentecostals did not teach. During my sermon that evening she came forward to be baptized into Christ and leave denominationalism.

On Saturday morning prior to our departure we met one last time in a large room to thank our Lord for this opportunity, summarize the work, and thank each individual for their service. Our second group met us on Friday in Brown's Town. Their work was to follow-up on all the contacts we made due to our VBS and medical mission. They were able to continue teaching and baptized Aaron Smith, Patricia Williams, and many more yet to respond.

Overall it was one of the most inspiring trips I have ever served. Brothers and Sisters worked from dawn to night for nine straight days. I am so thankful to every Christian and congregation who supported this work. Lord willing, we will return to Sandy Bay in 2010.

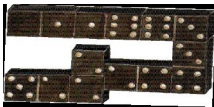

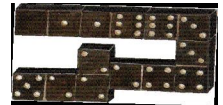
