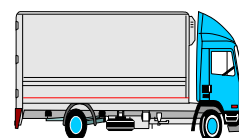

TEN MINUTES EARLY

The "good ole days", grandma used to get up on Sunday morning, cook a big breakfast for her large family. Milk the cows, churn butter, clean house, kill and dress the chickens for dinner, dress the children, then drive with the family in a buggy or wagon five miles to worship services and likely get there at least TEN MINUTES EARLY. Today when breakfast comes in a box, the milk, butter, chickens and most everything else comes from the grocery store. The distance to the church building is covered in minutes in a heated, cooled and all the other "bells and whistles" automobile it is still almost impossible for most folks to get to the church building on time for services.

It is alarming at the lackadaisical attitude about gathering with the Saints to study from God's Word and to Worship on time. It seems that we have a hard time getting to the services on time; we are steadily coming into the assembly late. Sure there are times that we just can't make it on time, but this should be exception and not the usual. Some would say, "well the first few minutes are wasted on welcoming and announcements" agreed, the first few minutes are spent on welcome and announcement but that is not wasted time. We should welcome each other, Romans 16:16, there are things that should and must be communicated to the church that you need to hear and this is accomplished through announcements.

One of the many strengths this congregation has is our friendliness, James 2:1-9 is not a problem for us. Let us all make a point to being at least TEN MINUTES EARLY to each service so we can greet our visitors and each other.

We all need encouragement, Ephesians 4:29, and before worshipping together or studying together is a great time for this to take place. Surely if they could do it in the "good ole days" we can accomplish the task of being on time today. See you TEN MINUTES EARLY before each service, I Corinthians 14:40 .

Monetary Donations (issued to the church), Eye Glasses, Pepcid or Zantac Tablets, Tums, Aspirin Coated 325 mg, Baby Aspirin 81 mg., Tylenol, Benadryl Tablets and cream, Neosporin Ointment, Hydrocortisone Cream Ibuprofen Tablets, First Aid Kits, Hand Wash - Germ Band-aids, Soft Tooth Brushes, Tooth Paste & Dental Floss

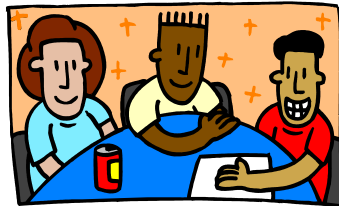
