Knock, Knock

One of my earliest memories was of my father laughing at my first ever joke. I still remember that "Knock-knock" joke that is only ever funny to a wee boy not yet started school and his dad. A while back, I took three of my children to see a movie and while driving out to the cinema, one of my girls started telling me "Knock-knock" jokes and then the others joined in. Before long we were all laughing. The jokes were little different from those of my early childhood and made no sense but we were just enjoying ourselves. A little laughter is good for the soul.

Of course, there is a difference between the joke and an actual knock at the door. Having young children, our household is used to other young children knocking at the door. It is at times persistent but it is good that children have friends and can play together and learn from their experiences.

Sometimes, the knock at the door is a friend or a neighbor and they have a need. Jesus told a parable about this in Luke 11:5-10. Persistence can pay off at times and when we hear that knocking at the door, we want to see who's there. Jesus teaches us that if we ask, we will receive; if we seek, we shall find; and, if we knock, the door will be opened to us.

It is also said that the other thing that knocks on our door is opportunity. In Revelation 3:20, Jesus told the church in Laodicea that He stood at the door and knocked. The question is, "Will you let Him in?" Christians in Laodicea were "lukewarm" and He rebuked them for their indifference. The same is true of many who "go to church": there is no joy in their worship; no compassion or love towards their neighbors; and, indifference towards the Lord Himself. He stands at our door and knocks and it behoves us to get off our backsides and answer it. Christianity is not for the lazy: we are called to work (Philippians 2:12; Ephesians 2:10). It is not for the selfish: we are called to give (2nd Corinthians 8:3-5; Romans 12:1-2). It is not for the compromising: we are called to take a stand for God (2nd Timothy 4:1-5; Acts 4:18-20; cf. Acts 7).

Jesus stands at the door and knocks but who will let Him in? This is no joke: there is no punch-line; this is eternally serious!
