The Simplicity of Giving

Every faithful Christian wants to give back to God, but sometimes everything else seems to come first and if we have anything left over, we give that to God. Most of us know that this is not what God desires, but we wonder what God really does expect of us. The formula for New Testament giving is really simple.

First, Paul tells us to "set aside a sum of money in keeping with (our) income." (1 Corinthians 16:2) That simply means we give back to God an amount corresponding to what we have received. Then, Paul tells us that "each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give" (2 Corinthians 9:7) That simply means we plan ahead to give back to God that which we have "set aside." Finally, Paul tells us that "God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Corinthians 9:7) That simply means we should not look at giving as a burden, but as an opportunity to show God how much we appreciate what He gives us each day.

If each of us gave in this manner, the Church would be able to do the work of the Lord without any financial worry! *"And God is able to make grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work."* (2 Corinthians 9:8) The question is - do we really have enough faith in God to give as He has told us?
