The Value of a Good Teacher

Solomon said, "Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it" (Proverbs 22:6 NKJV). Friends, it is very important that everyone receives good instruction from teachers who are prepared to impart God's wisdom. A good teacher, well prepared, caring for his/her students, is a treasure.

Good teaching involves more than a simple transfer of facts. A good teacher will study the Word daily and apply the message to the needs of his or her class. A good teacher will also have a healthy respect for others, a desire for morality, and a view toward a life-long love of learning.

Good teachers spend many hours in preparation of their lessons. They study the Word, use additional resources, and spend time in prayer for their students. They pray that God's Word will produce good fruit (Isaiah 55:11). Their hearts are uplifted when you show up for class and participate. Their hearts are broken when decisions are made to skip a class or drop out.

We should always have a desire to learn more about God and the ways He wants us to live. We should be grateful for the opportunities we have to gather together and learn.

Encourage a teacher today; they have the responsibility to teach the Word to all students. Isaiah also teaches us that the fear of wisdom and knowledge is indeed a treasure to the Lord. 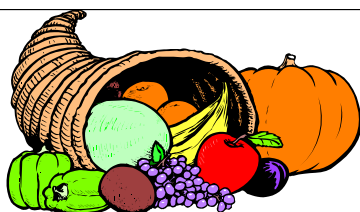
